Fire Safety and Cooking Guidelines for the NATEVA Festival

The Town of Oxford welcome's you to the NATEVA Festival. We hope you enjoy the Festival and have a safe weekend, to assist with this effort we have included some basic requests to ensure the safety of all. The Oxford Fire and Rescue will have staff on the grounds at all times and will be checking that the below requests are followed.

1. A minimum of 3 feet of clearance shall be maintained at all times while cooking appliance is in use. No combustible material shall be within 3 feet of the cooking appliance.
2. Cooking appliances utilizing Propane and Charcoal are permitted. No wood or combustible/flammable liquid cooking appliances are permitted.
3. One cooking appliance per site permitted.
4. Maximum amount of Propane allowed per site will be 20 pounds.
5. Cooking appliances shall only be used during the hours of 7am, and 10pm
6. Cooking appliances when in use shall not be unattended
